The night event this year was held at Acacia Bay, Taupo and orienteers from throughout the country camped down for the night amidst the noise of enraged bulls and other anxious orienteers. Scenes reminiscent of the miners about to set off down the pits greeted those who watched at the start caravan. Then the first runners were off, and it was a toss-up of going to bed for a short rest, or of watching the lights of the torches as the first runners roamed over the surrounding countryside. One of the activities seen by those watching included the sight of two torch-lights far apart suddenly merging, and then being extinguished. Obviously some common understanding had been reached by those 2 orienteers and this may have included the locating of a control.

The Hawke's Bay team was Fiona Crawford, Maree Atkins, Roger Bee, Linda Lloyd, Michael Alexander, Maurice Lloyd and Bob Lester. All performed with distinction in the testing conditions - marathon type courses, long grass, excited cows and bulls, unmapped tomos. Maree Atkins will not forget the unmarked cow she located in the unmarked tomo, but swam off her experience the next morning in the hot pools at Taupo. Driving back from Taupo was a tiring experience for one of the team, who tried to stay awake by stopping at Te Haroto for some scones and tea. Luckily his eyes stayed open long enough to enable him to safely drop off his passengers and the writer has been told that the driver, once home, collapsed on the bed and could not be wakened by his family until one more night had passed. In summary, an enjoyable event, well run (bring back David Miller to remap those tomos!) and remembered (fondly - hardly!) by those that went. Hopefully next year several teams from Hawke's Bay will travel to this exciting event.
