Club Event: Craggy Range

Setting Craggy Range was a fun but challenging experience. I found out that I was setting a course on Craggy Range in about January. At the time I planned to download Condes and get the map file from David Fisher a couple of months in advance of the day of the event.

About a month and a half out from the event no progress had been made on downloading Condes and getting the map file. So I decided to make it top of my priorities and downloaded Condes and got the map file from David. Once I got the map file I had had no idea how to open it so I had to email David a couple of times before it finally opened.

When I opened the file I didn't realise how big the map actually was! I already had an idea about where the course was going to be before I had started. So after a quick play around (2-3 hours) I finally got the hang of Condes and had done the first draft of courses. It was not until the next day that I had a look at the map again and noticed that all of the fences that I was using on the course were actually impassable (the deer fences just south of where I started my event). So I had to start again and with the intention of wanting to use the patch of pine forest that is in the north part of the map I set to work.

A couple of days later the draft of courses were finished. I decided to email Jon Eames (my vetter) for the first time to ask if we could organise a time to get out onto the farm. After trying several different emails I finally got hold of Jon. The only problem that we had was I was going to be on Great Barrier Island during the holidays and then had NISS orienteering the next day. So we organised a time to go out and check control sites, the day after North Islands.

The Sunday that we went and checked the control sites everything went pretty smoothly for us. No new features to worry about, no features had disappeared that were to be used for controls and only the one electric fence to worry about (Jon found out the hard way and so did a few others on the day of event).

On the day of the event everything went reasonably smoothly for us. The only problem we had that I sorted out was that the tape to the triangle had been cut up into lots of pieces by the sheep during the night. After a quick herd up of the sheep to push them to the other side of the forest, everything was set to go for people to start their race.

Overall I was very pleased with how my whole setting of a course went (I am probably saying this because everything went along without a hitch!) but what impressed me even more was the number of people that came and ran courses. The number that ran was around the 250 mark, which is astonishing for a club

event. It was good also to see that there were hardly any mispunches.

I would like to especially thank Jon for his support and help he gave to me, I think it helped my experience a lot. Also to Philip and Pam for looking after the computers, Mum and Bianca for collecting money in the caravan, Dad, Derek, Jane and Geoff for picking up controls afterwards and Roger for organising the land owner permission and the extra water that was much appreciated.

Can't wait to set my next course, bring it on!

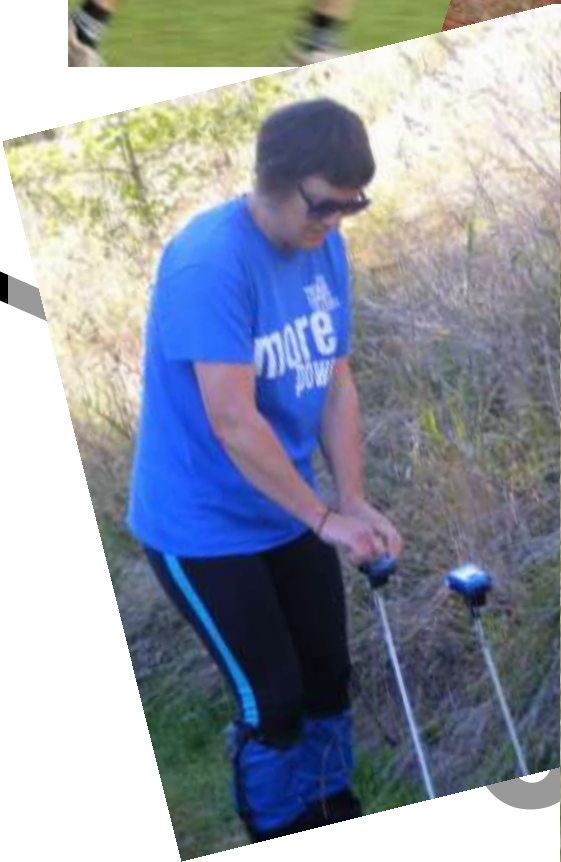

Being a schools' event this had the added advantage of having lots of club members around who were more than willing to help out. This made things really easy and all I had to focus on was planning and putting out controls. Thanks to everyone who helped out. In particular I would like to thanks Amber Morrison for her help as vetter and also David Fisher, Phillip Herries, Karen Beckman, Pamela Morrision, Catherine Howell and Duncan Morrison for their work helping the event come together.

Overall it was a good experience, it improved my understanding of how the club functions as well as improving my knowledge about sprint orienteering. I hope everyone enjoyed the courses and I look forward to planning more events in the future.
