
## 2015 Hawke's Bay Schools Individual Long Championships

Scale:	1:10,000 for orange and red courses, 5m contours 1:7,500 for yellow and white courses, 5m contours				
Terrain & map notes	Spur gully farmland with patches of native bush and rock features. Fences are not shown on red courses. All maps, except red courses, include a legend. Leg cover is recommended for red and orange courses only.				
Out of bounds:	Orange courses run close to some paddocks that have been re-sown recently and are marked as Out-of-Bounds on the map with purple stripes. <i>Competitors may run around the edge of the out-of-bounds paddocks but do not run across them.</i> All farmland, and the driveway past the turn-off to the woolshed, is out-of-bounds				

for competitors before they run.

Please stay in the event centre, carpark or start area or on the signposted routes between these areas. The event centre has been situated to allow good views of competitors at the finish.

Directions: The event centre is at the Tauroa Station woolshed. From Havelock North turn right at the end of Te Mata Road and right again into Matangi Road immediately before Red Bridge. Event is sign posted from here. Allow 15 minutes drive from Havelock North.

Parking:	For all vehicles event parking is along the driveway before the turn-off to the woolshed. You will have a 300m – 800m walk to the event centre from the parking.				
Registration:	At the club caravan at the event centre on west side of woolshed. Open from 8.30am. Please get one team representative only to collect all hired sport idents for the team. Use only the sport ident allocated to you and return the ident at the finish.				
	Some base plate and thumb compasses will be available to hire from the caravan. These must be returned after the event otherwise there will be a charge to the competitor via your school to replace the compass.				
Start:	Signposted from the club caravan. Start is 100m past the event centre.				
	Start times will be notified in the start list available from the HB Orienteering website from Wednesday 3 June. <b>FIRST STARTS WILL BE FROM 9.30am.</b>				
	Competitors must be at the start ready to run no less than 5 minutes before their start time. Be prepared by knowing your grade and course number.				
Finish:	The finish is on the west side of the woolshed. Binoculars may be useful for observing the racing.				
	All competitors must report to the finish, even if they do not complete the course.				
Results:	Provisional live results will be displayed on the O-Lynx screens at the Event Centre. Unofficial live results will also be available on the web at <u>www.o-lynxlive.com</u> for family and friends at home. Official results will be available after the event at <u>www.hborienteering.com</u> .				
Prizegiving:	At the carpark no later than 12 noon. Prizegiving will be completed by 12.30pm.				
Whistles:	Competitors are encouraged to carry a whistle. The distress signal is 6 short blasts, rest, then repeat. Use in the case of injury or emergency only.
