EVENT INFORMATION

The events start on the west coast of the North Island in the Manawatu [three events] then travel down to Wellington [Sprint], over to the Wairarapa on the east coast [Oceania Long & Relays] and up to the Hawke's Bay [World Cup prologue race & chasing start plus final race in the Multi day event]

The terrain for the races is varied including:

- fast sand dune forest
- open sand dunes
- rolling gully spur farmland with pockets of bush & pine plantations
- forested gully spur
- open farmland with intricate limestone rock

As New Zealand is situated in the Southern Hemisphere, overseas competitors will require a compass that is suitable for this part of the world. These will be available for sale at the event.

The SportIdent system will be used at all events. E-cards can be hired at the event

Entries before 1st July 2012 have a reduced scale of fees, entries from 1st July to 2nd December 2012 pay the full fees. A discount applies if you enter all seven individual events.

Entries close on 2nd December 2012. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries received after this date. Late entries may be accepted but will be subject to a surcharge of \$50. These entries will not appear in the Programme.

In the event of cancellation for any reason the organisers of Oceania World Cup 2013 reserve the right to retain all or part of the entry fee to recover incurred costs

Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

Note 1: Mass start for Men and MW12 at 10:00am, mass start for Women and MW Mixed Short at 10:10am; mass start for all not-yet-started leg 2 and 3 competitors at approximately 12 noon.

Note 2: Course 15 (the MWsm1 class) is a mixed difficulty course with no age restrictions. First leg is a short-length easy-navigation leg, second leg is long-length difficult-navigation and third leg is medium-length medium-navigation. The legs approximate courses 13, 3 and 10 in terms of controls, length and climb, with actual numbers shown in leg order in the table.

Note 3: For the AUS-NZL challenge, the nominated teams run on the course for their age class in the table above

Australia – New Zealand Challenge

The Challenge will consist of an Individual Challenge, based on the Oceania Long Distance, Middle Distance and Sprint Distance Championships, and a Relay Challenge, based on the Oceania Relay Championships.

As visiting nation, Orienteering Australia, has indicated it will be contesting the following classes:

Note that M and W 21A will not be part of the challenge because of the World Cup races in 21E classes being held at the same time.

- NZOF Levy will be payable for persons not affiliated to any orienteering club/organization. \$9.00 per senior, \$5.50 per junior, or \$23.50 per family, for each day. (if you are a member of any official orienteering club on planet earth you do not pay this levy.)

2. Credit cards – (Visa & MasterCard):

If you select the “Credit Card” payment type on the online entryform you will be, optionally, re-directed to the ANZ eGate secure payment website at the end of the entryform process.

Credit card payments can also be made by selecting the “Payment by credit card” option from the Online Entries Menu and then entering the payment details, before being re-directed to the ANZ eGate website.

Note that credit card payment incurs a NZ\$10.00 banking fee. If you selected the “Credit Card” payment type the banking fee is included in the “Total to pay” on the completed entryform. If the banking fee is not shown on the completed entryform you must add it to the “Total to pay”.
