

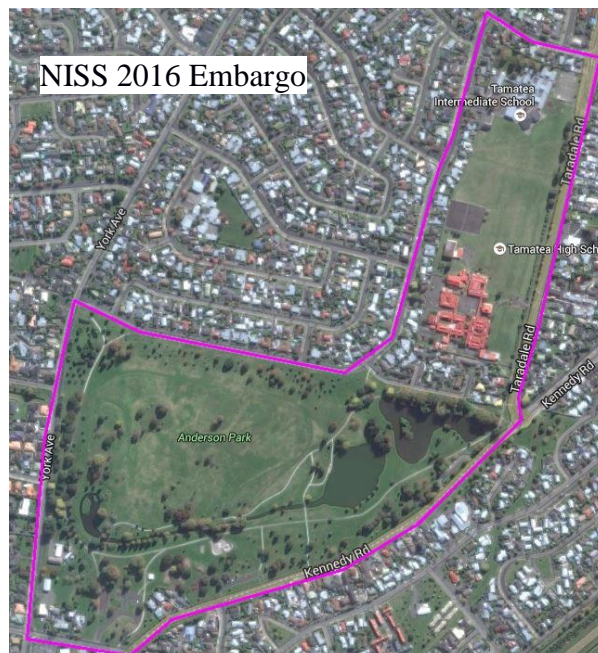
# NORTH ISLAND SECONDARY SCHOOLS ORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

## EMBARGO

Three areas are embargoed for the NISS Orienteering Championships 2016 to be held in Hawke's Bay 28-30 April 2016. Example maps of these areas will be provided on the HBOC website closer to the event.

### Sprint Championship:

Competitors and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competition, are permitted to access the embargoed area (with public access) until further notice. However, use of orienteering maps, orienteering training of all kinds and route choice testing is not allowed in the area. The only exception is for those competitors who may live, work or study within the area covered by the map for running training only while going about their normal daily activity to and from their place of work or residence. From 1 February 2016 until the start of the sprint on Thursday 28 April 2016 the above embargo conditions apply to the area defined by: All Tamatea High School, Tamatea Intermediate School grounds, and Anderson Park and surrounding roads bounding the school grounds and park, including Taradale Road, Freyberg Ave, York Ave, Auckland Road and Kennedy Road.



### Individual Long Championship:

From 1 February 2016 until the start of the long course on Friday 29 April 2016 the area covered by the map known as Waipoapoa, (ie) all farmland at the southern end of Waipoapoa Road, is embargoed: use of orienteering maps, running training of all kinds and route choice testing is not allowed in the area.



### Relay Championship:

From 1 February 2016 until the start of the relay course on Saturday 30 April 2016 the area covered by the map known as Te Awanga, (ie) farmland and forest west of Clifton Road between Te Awanga village and Charlton Road, is embargoed: use of orienteering maps, running training of all kinds and route choice testing is not allowed in the area.
