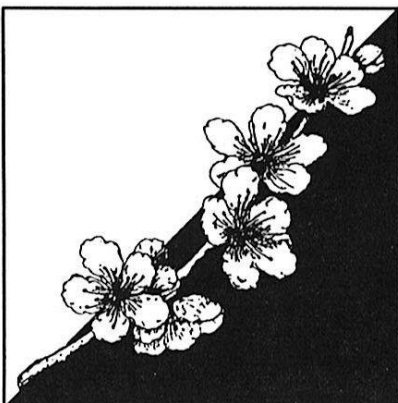

Blossom Junior Club Challenge - this competition will be held in conjunction with the 3-Day. It will be open to all competitors in classes from M/W12 - M/W18. Points will be awarded to each finisher in these grades, with the club accumulating the most points being the winner.

ACCOMMODATION

Hawkes Bay is a popular Labour Weekend destination, therefore we recommend booking accommodation early.

To assist, we have booked the Omatua Guide Centre for the weekend. Omatua is situated approximately 20 minutes north-west of Napier and is well located for access to Tangoio and The Slump.

- INDOORS** - single beds, average 6 per room - capacity 60
 - central kitchen, showers, dining room and hall
- CAMPING** - pleasant camping area, toilets, running water
 - kitchen, shower facilities are limited, therefore we recommend campers be self-sufficient

Indoor accommodation will be allocated on a first in, first served basis. Accommodation will be available from Friday, October 25 to Monday, October 28.
